

Owasco Lake report for FLRWA 7/18/22

- 1) Ann Robson was elected President of OWLA in our June Annual meeting. Ann's email address is ann_robson@owla.org.
- 2) OWLA was voted Non-Profit of the Year 2022 by the Cayuga County Chamber of Commerce. An awards ceremony was held with media coverage.
- 3) Stream sampling is continuing to support the Owasco Lake Watershed modeling program.
- 4) Outreach and Education is active in the Moravia and Auburn school districts. Watershed and water quality are featured.
- 5) HAB Surveillance monitoring started on 7/11/22 with 25 zones around Owasco Lake.
- 6) OWLA has completed our spring HWA survey and treatment program. A total of 6,328 hemlocks have been treated during the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 period. The Spring 2022 effort treated 2811 hemlocks at a cost of \$49,950 or \$17.41 per tree.
