- a. Honeoye Lake level was at 803.8 feet currently. About 6 inches higher than normal.
- b. We plan to start collecting water quality data the week of May 9th.
- c. We will start publishing our weekly water quality bog in mid-May. We get 50-100 blog views weekly.
