This summer we have held two harvesters to date, doing a great job with clearing the Curly Pond weed prior to the busy July 4th activities. Another harvest is planned in the beginning of August. Several residents have commented positively on the OLPA efforts. The 2017 grant is in its third year and all targets are being met in identifying the vegetation of our lake. Although we do have the common eurasian milfoil and curly pondweed we are still absent of starry stonewort, hydrilla and quagga mussels. All target items are expected to be met in June of 2020. Another grant was awarded this year to supplement the stewards at the two marinas as well as a third DEC boat launch to begin construction in the fall. Coming up on July 20th is the Annual 5K/2mile walk Otisco Lake Watershed Shuffle. Besides the run a dozen baskets are being prepared by lake residents for raffle after the run/walk. This is a fundraiser as well as a fun community event.
